About the Doc and Jean Chaffee Scholarship

This scholarship is named after Dr. Paul Chaffee, who served for 28 years as veterinarian and 25 years as director of the Fresno Zoo. The zoo was renamed the Fresno Chaffee Zoo in July of 1990, prior to his death.

Paul Chaffee made major improvements for exotic animals through medical care practices, nutrition, natural habitats, and detailed record-keeping. He was a visionary leader respected by his contemporaries. This scholarship is open to animal science, plant science, or conservation majors who want to follow in Paul Chaffee's footsteps. Jean Chaffee is his widow.

Eligibility

The Doc and Jean Chaffee Scholarship is open to

- Graduating high school seniors entering college majoring in animal science, plant science, or conservation.
- Continuing college students (Sophomore Senior) majoring in animal science, plant science, or conservation.
- Adults entering college for the first time, or reentering college, seeking a degree in animal science, plant science, or conservation.
- All applicants must be majoring in animal science, plant science, or conservation.
- Employees of the Fresno Chaffee Zoo and past participants of the summer internship program at the Fresno Chaffee Zoo are encouraged to apply.
- Those seeking advanced degrees and working full time are allowed part time school status.
- Applicants must demonstrate extraordinary academic growth, financial need, community service, and school participation.

Applicants must be available for a possible interview with the selection committee.

If applicants are unable to meet in person, online or phone interview may be scheduled.

Selection Process

The scholarship committee will judge each application in a nondiscriminatory and objective manner. The following details the criteria the committee will use to judge applications, and the accompanying weight each criterion carries in regard to the committee's decisions:

- Academic growth/improvement (50% weight)
- Community and school activities (20% weight)
- Financial need (30% weight)
